WORK HOURS: FULL-TIME Sunday to Thursday and On-Call as Needed

PRINCIPLE FUNCTION

The Community Life Pastor will be responsible for building and overseeing ministries that focus on missions, evangelism and ensuring that The Antioch Fellowship Church has ministries focused on building beyond the walls of the church by developing leaders to change the world around us. The Community Life Pastor will work closely with both Executive Pastors and discipleship team to ensure that leaders are being developed and deployed into the world not just in the church.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead the planning and preparation for domestic, national and global mission trips and programs
- Create new and oversee all existing evangelistic programs and ministries such as Restoration (Prison) ministry
- Create and oversee ministries and teachings designed to build and develop “marketplace” ministers
- Create and oversee ministry internship program
- Create new and oversee existing Justice Ministry programs and projects such as Antioch Legal Clinic
- Create political advocacy programs to ensure community development and healthy partnerships with our legislators.
- Oversee general leadership development as part of our discipleship process

Additional Duties

- a. Cooperate with the Senior Pastor, Associate Pastors, Board of Trustees and other staff members in promoting the entire ministry plan of Antioch Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church.
- b. Be available for spiritual consultation of church and non-church members as needs arise.
- c. Submitting information on a timely basis to members of the media team for announcements via TWAA and website.
- d. Utilize the services of the support staff, which are consistent with their Position Descriptions.
- e. Supply written updates of changes to programming related to Community Life to all members of the staff and others (Ministry leaders).
- f. Give full support to the Unified General Operating Budget of Antioch Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church and avoid soliciting or expending funds not previously authorized.
- g. Assist with teaching, preaching, visitation and other assignments upon request.
- h. Attend all staff meetings (General and Pastoral) unless given permission from the Executive Pastor to be absent

Basic personal responsibilities:

- a. Maintain a vital and growing personal walk with the Lord through committed Bible study, prayer and meditation.
- b. Maintain proper priorities in your home
- c. Develop personal evangelism opportunities within and outside the church.
- d. Financially support the works of ministries of Antioch Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church by faithfully giving at least 10% of your gross income. Maintain wise stewardship measures over the remaining 90%.

Qualifications

- Lead strategically to raise up and grow Community leadership and move mission forward.
- Build systems and structures that facilitate mission through multiplication and ministry by serving among the body.

- Lead Teams to be equipped and encouraged toward effectiveness and efficiency in ministry.
- Bachelor's degree or MDIV preferred, and minimum 3-5 years of vocational ministry experience preferred.
- Has a passion for seeing people become connected to the church
- Energetic, organized, and self-motivated
- Is a team player with excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- A relevant professional qualification such as in Christian ministry, community work, youth work, theology, social work
- Passion for community building and experience in working with people in a community setting. Skills in community engagement, development.
- Ability to work with both the staff and congregation
